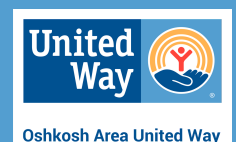

## HOW YOUR DOLLAR MAKES A DIFFERENCE

Your gift through the Oshkosh Area United Way stays in our community to support over 40 local programs that address critical needs for our friends and neighbors.

### \$1 Per Week

- 21 days of meals for a family of 4
- Homework assistance for 10 students
- Six months of personalized case management for a homeless individual

### \$2 Per Week

- Three meals a day for five low-income students for more than one month
- One book a month for one year for 4 preschoolers
- 85 bus tokens for shelter guests to get around town

### \$5 Per Week

- Provides more than 1,100 lunches to low-income students
- Provides 10 children with an annual scholarship to an after school program
- Free tax preparation services for 20 tax payers

### \$10 Per Week

- Provides mental wellness programming for more than 300 children
- A wellness visit, nutritious meal and continued independence for 105 seniors
- One year of diapers for a child

### \$20 Per Week

- Free dental visits for more than 30 children
- Weekly support for 8 survivors of child abuse for a year
- 3 meals a day for 20 families of 4 for three weeks
